PLANT CARE INFORMATION

Pink Skullcap Scutellaria suffrutescens

DESCRIPTION: Pink Skullcap makes a great little groundcover. This compact plant will generally grow to about 8" tall by 1-2'wide, possibly a little bigger in the shade. Flushes of pink flowers that look like little snapdragons will grace this plant from spring through fall.

RECOMMENDED USE: Skullcap combines well with other xeriscape plants and will provide a nice change of pace. Use as a ground cover, border, rock garden, or in a container.

CULTURE:



Hardiness: 0°F.

Sun tolerance: In hot, low desert locations this plant will do best with some afternoon shade, but does great in full sun elsewhere.

Watering and feeding: Low to moderate water use. Feed in spring and summer.

Soil requirements: Soils that drain.



Pruning: In colder areas it might need a good hard pruning in the spring to remove frost damaged foliage.
