## **Sierra Apricot** ® *Tecoma* hybrid P.P. 20246

**DESCRIPTION:** Sierra Apricot® is smaller than previous *Tecoma* selections, with a compact and dense form. Because it is seedless, this clone blooms continuously throughout the summer months with large clusters of apricot colored, bell-shaped flowers. Hummingbirds love the tubular blossoms. In mild climates Sierra Apricot® remains mostly evergreen, but is deciduous below temperatures of 25°F.

**RECOMMENDED USE:** Use as a colorful accent, border, or in a well-lit patio container.

## **CULTURE:**

Hardiness: 15°F.

Sun tolerance: Full sun is best.



Watering and feeding: Low to moderate. Feed in spring and early summer.

Soil requirements: Any soil that drains will do.

**Pruning**: Prune hard after last frost
